In a bumper day of NCIC action, two divisions saw back-to-back titles whilst Victoria were crowned winners in the Intellectual Disability division.


WINE SHOW

Our funding was greatly assisted by Sir Ian Botham's Wine Show in February – a sold out event held at the Kooyong Tennis Club.




AUSTRALIAN CRICKET SOCIETY
